Per the December 2021 Attorney General Guideline “Promoting Diversity in Law Enforcement Recruiting and Hiring,” the Brielle Police Department is committed to taking necessary steps to ensure that the staff we hire reflects the community that we serve. Additionally, as mandated by N.J.S.A. 52:17B-4.10., we report our efforts annually.

2019 Census data showed that the Borough of Brielle’s population was 96% White, 2.1% Hispanic, 1.3% Black or African American, and 0.3% Asian.

As of December 31, 2022, the Brielle Police Department employed eighteen sworn officers: 94% were White, 6% were Black or African American; 11% of the sworn officers were female.
